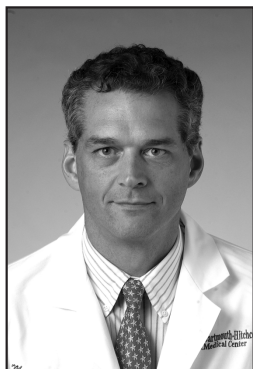


Health Tips

The Oncology Infusion Service is located on the first floor of the new addition to New London Hospital. In addition to chemotherapy, other services offered by the Oncology Infusion Service include transfusions, outpatient antibiotics, IV fluids, IV medications for iron deficiency, rheumatoid arthritis, neuromuscular disorders, and osteoporosis. Services are provided by a specialized medical and nursing team.

New London Hospital's oncology program is part of the Regional Cancer Program of the Norris Cotton Cancer Center at Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center (DHMC). Dartmouth oncologist Marc Gautier, MD treats patients and provides consultation. Elizabeth Kintis, RN, MS, ARNP, a DHMC Nurse Practitioner, works with Dr. Gautier.
