Transcript:

I think the community as a whole really takes pride in New London Hospital.

This community has rallied around this hospital ever since its beginning and had fundraisers and Hospital Days. They come out and support them. We have volunteers from the community, it's an owning and a joint partnership of healthcare. We may be the providers, but they're the supporters. And we wouldn't be able to do it without a lot of the community support.

Being a small community hospital is where I need to be getting out of school. I thought, okay, well maybe I'm going to go to a big, a big center, but being in the community and being able to see my neighbors and have that connection with them is really where I need to be. And I know it helps to put the patients and my friends and my family at ease when they come in.

What I have enjoyed about New Hampshire is the sanity, the calmness.

It's beautiful. It really is beautiful. There's nothing to match it. The lakes are pristine. We have hiking and biking and skiing. We have anything that an outdoor enthusiast would want, but in the same breath, the Lake Sunapee region also offers an artistic community. We have Colby Sawyer college that has a theater department. We have several dance studios around that perform every year and we have the barn Playhouse Lake Sunapee region. It offers quite a bit.
